Sing a song to the Lord!




Family Faith Fun

Way back in the 7th century a man called Caedmon looked after the cows belonging to a monastery. He couldn't read or write or sing to save his life, which bothered him when he was younger. But as he grew old he accepted that he couldn't sing and was content. Then one night he fell sleep in the cowshed and dreamt that a voice called his name and said "Caedmon, sing me a song".



Caedmon protested that he couldn't sing but the voice said, "Sing to me a song about Creation." In his dream he began to sing in praise of God and perfectly in tune! When he woke up he could remember it exactly and found he could add extra words. He eventually went to see the head of the monastery, Abbess Hilda, who was amazed. She put him to the test by telling him stories from the Bible and asking him to make up songs about them, which he could now do.

In the picture can you see Caedmon asleep with the cattle and an angel in his dream. Then below we see him writing down the words and finally teaching the monks his songs. He became a pop-star of his day.

Caedmon died around AD670 and is specially remembered on 11th February.
