Something special is about to happen! We're on the countdown to Christmas.

But are we ready for it? This month there is a weekly craft activity leading you to Christmas.

Week One – Preparing Ourselves Hundreds of years ago, a man called lasiah tried to tell the people that God was going to send someone, a Messiah, to lead them to a new Kingdom of Heaven.

Isaiah was a Prophet, a man who listened to God and tried to pass on messages to the people. Isaiah said they were to be ready for when this new King comes. It was to be many years before Isaiah's words came true and most people had given up hope. But we know what happened so we can prepare to celebrate that new King who came as a humble baby.

How should we prepare ourselves?

As the Christmas lights go on they remind us that light helps us to see those things that need to be cleaned or tidied away. Do we need to prepare our hearts for Christmas by saying



sorry for anything we have said or done that has hurt others. Draw & cut out a heart shape, make it sparkly if you can.

Write the word sorry on it and hang it up somewhere, perhaps on your Christmas tree.



Week 2 - Thinking of Others

At Christmas we are often asked to think about those less fortunate than ourselves – refugees, the homeless, those suffering war, the hungry, the sick and the elderly. Perhaps you could think of some of these sorts of people and make a paper prayer chain to hang on your Christmas tree at home or in your church. Add several links to the chain for each group of people you think about. Perhaps you could write the words 'refugees', 'homeless' etc on each group of links. You might like to use a different colour for each group and add sticky stars as decorations.

Week 3 Angels, God's Messengers




The angels played an important part in the story of Jesus' birth. First of all Angel Gebriel was sent to tell Mary that

God wanted the whole world to know about Jesus, which is why he sent a special star to guide some men from countries far away to find Him. The wise men saw a new star in the sky and followed it. They brough precious gifts to give to Jesus. If you were a visitor to that stable, what gift would you take for the baby? Think about all those children (and adults) who will not be getting any presents this year because they are homeless, on their own, or living where there is war. Pray for those who try to help these people.
